- Conformation entries close At 8:30 AM and 12:30 PM.
- Judging begins at 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM or 1/2 hour after the morning trial on Saturday beginning with Utility
- Classes include Jr. Showmanship, 2-4 puppies , 4-6 puppies, 6-9, 9-12, 12-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners & Best Of Breed and all Altered Classes
- Conformation Classes are only open to registered Australian Shepherds
- All Australian Shepherds over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration.

Registration & Tracking

- All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.
- Effective January 1, 2004: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. Entry Information

- Complete each dog on a *separate entry form for each class and each show*. Do not forget to sign the back of the entry form
- Include a legible copy your ASCA Registration for each dog.
- Send legible e-mail address to receive confirmation and show times.
- All Dogs must have proof of registration and rabies certificate available.
- For information regarding what Obedience classes you may enter, refer to the Obedience rules on the ASCA site: <http://www.asca.org>
- The Novice A Class is for handlers that have not placed a C.D. title on a dog from any registry and the dog does not have a C.D. title from any registry. For the Open A and Utility A classes, your dog must not have earned an Open or Utility title in any registry.
- All dogs competing for ASCA Obedience titles are required to start at Novice and work through Utility regardless of Obedience titles awarded by other Registries. ASCA Obedience judges may not enter or handle in the A classes.
- All dogs must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or an ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials.
- **Obedience is Pre Entry Only** by Monday May 4, 2009 for all classes,
- Conformation of entries and notice of approximate times will be sent after closing date.

- All Obedience classes are \$18.00
- Conformation fees are JR. \$5.00, Non-Regular classes\$10.00 and Regular classes\$18.00

Directions

From The West: Route 17 to Exit 124 (Goshen/Florida) Left at Light onto Route 17A towards Florida, NY. Come into the Village of Florida and at the Second traffic Light Turn Right Go about 3 ½ or 4 miles to Park on the Left

From The East: Route 17 to Exit 124 (Goshen/Florida) Left at the Traffic Light onto Route 17A towards Florida, NY then follow directions above.

From NJ Route 23: Travel Route 23 to route 515 (see signs for Mountain Creek Ski area and Resort) Travel Route 515 for about 15 miles or so You will come to a traffic light Go Straight at that Light you are now on Route 94 . You will see the sign Welcome to NY. Go about another 3 miles or so to Route 1A (you will see a OCHS Orchard sign on your right) Make a Left onto Route 1A Go to Second Blinker light and Turn Right onto Union Corners Road (Edenville) Go straight at Yield sign. Park will then be on the Right side about 1 and half miles up the road.

Look for posted signs which mark the show grounds.
