

PEN-NY ASC will be hosting Two rally shows in conjunction with our agility trials at Honeycreek Farm, 7 Sunset Circle West, Ithaca, NY on October 8-9, 2011

Saturday am: - Regular classes (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Masters)

Saturday pm: – Non-regular class – Rally/snooker (w/novice and advanced signs)

Sunday am: - Regular classes (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Masters)

Morning show begins at 9:00 am in the following order: Masters, Excellent, Advanced, Novice

Afternoon non-regular class begins 1/2 hr after am show ends.

Awards Offered: Rosettes and travel mugs for HIT overall, High Scoring Aussie, High Scoring Junior and High combined score; flats offered for placements, qualifying and “X” qualifying scores, rosettes for new titles. Non-regular class will offer flats and stuffed animals for placements.

NON-REGULAR CLASS – RALLY/SNOOKER - Stay after the rally show on Saturday and get some extra practice in playing on a rally/snooker course. For those of you who haven't played snooker in agility, we will have three signs that are “red” signs and you will need to do a red sign before you can go out on the course and do a “colored” sign. Each sign will have a number assigned to it and the object is to gather up as many points as possible. After completing each red sign/colored sign combination, you will then complete the whole numbered course. Each sign can only be competed once during the color combination part of the course. The very first sign on the snooker class will be Heeling and Conduct so while time is a consideration on a snooker course, the Heeling and Conduct will be judged throughout the whole course. Signs being used are the novice and advanced signs and the class will be on leash. Scores are calculated based on the number of points gathered between the combinations and the finished numbered course at the end and adding them to the point value earned for performing each sign. Penny has graciously agreed to stay and judge this for us and we'll have ribbons and prizes at the end.

***A Note About ASCA Obedience and Rally Trials:** ASCA sanctioned trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds eligible for registry with another club (including AKC and AMBOR). This is an actual trial and dogs of all breeds are eligible for titles. Dogs with titles or legs in other registries must begin at the novice level in ASCA. Visit the ASCA site for more details (asca.org). To enter in obedience and rally a dog must have an ASCA tracking number or ASCA registration number. Lodging and Directions to Honey Creek Farm

DIRECTIONS:

From the South-West - take rt 17 (I-86) to Route 13, follow rt. 13 through Ithaca. Take route 13N from Ithaca. Turn left on to Lower Creek Road. 4-H Acres will be on your left. Continue on Lower Creek Road to the 4-way stop sign. Take a left onto Pickney Road at the 4-way stop sign. Go one country block on Pickney Road and take the first left (dead end road) on to 7 Sunset West Circle. Susan's property is on the left hand side

From the North-East – From the thruway take the RT 81 South exit in Syracuse. Stay on Route 81 S until the Route 281S exit in Homer then turns into 13S. Stay on Route 13S through Dryden. Then turn right after the right of 366 to Pickney Road directly across from NYSE & G service parking lot. Continue on Pickney road crossing over Lower Creek Road and then take your first left onto Sunset West Circle

From the South - Take I-81 north to Whitney Point, Rt. 79 exit. Take Rt. 79 north to Richford, turn right at Rt. 38 towards Dryden. Turn left onto Rt. 13. Turn right on to Lower Creek Road. Then follow the directions from the Southwest.

From the North - Take I-81 south to Rt. 13 (Cortland), follow Rt. 13 south to Dryden and at the intersection with Rt. 38, turn right onto Rt. 13. Continue on Rt. 13 and turn right on to Lower Creek Road. Then follow the directions from the Southwest.

Food: There will be no food vendor on site but the club will be bringing in subs from Subway for workers. For those who are unable to work, a donation can be made to the food fund if they wish.
