To help us prepare for our pre-trial at nationals, we will be offering all the High in Trial Awards that we will be offering at the Nationals this year. Those agility awards will be High in Trial Novice, Open and Elite out of the Standard Division; High in Trial Overall, High Scoring Junior and High in Trial Veteran. Qualifying ribbons and placements are flats; all special awards, new title awards and ATCH ribbons are rosettes. Special awards will also be awarded a travel mug filled with treats.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE SHOW AND SITE

**\*A Note About ASCA Obedience and Rally Trials:** ASCA sanctioned trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds eligible for registry with another club (including AKC and AMBOR). This is an actual trial and dogs of all breeds are eligible for titles. Dogs with titles or legs in other registries must begin at the novice level in ASCA.
