***A Note About ASCA Obedience Trials:** ASCA sanctioned trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds eligible for registry with another club (including AKC and AMBOR). This is an actual trial and dogs of all breeds are eligible for titles. Dogs with titles or legs in other registries must begin at the novice level in ASCA. DIRECTIONS:

From the New York State Thruway

1. NYS Thruway to Exit 44 (Canandaigua).
2. Rt. 332 South to Rt. 96 (2nd light).
3. Turn left (east) onto Route 96.
4. Turn right (south) at the first light onto Beaver Creek Road.
5. The Boom Towne Canine Campus will be on your right.

BOOM TOWNE'S DOG PARK is open to the public for a fee. Use of the Dog Park is not included in the agility trial entry fee. If you wish to use the Dog Park please check in with the Boom Towne front desk staff.

CRATING AT BOOM TOWNE - Crating space will be available in the room off the main area and also limited crating in the main room in designated areas. The trial site requests a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Set up for agility will be allowed Friday all day until 8 pm. The building is locked at 9 PM. Crates may be left overnight; however, the PEN-NY ASC and the Boom Towne Canine Campus will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

- Don't leave your dog unattended, take them with you.
