***A Note About ASCA Obedience and Rally Trials:** ASCA sanctioned trials are open to all breeds and mixed breeds eligible for registry with another club (including AKC and AMBOR). This is an actual trial and dogs of all breeds are eligible for titles. Dogs with titles or legs in other registries must begin at the novice level in ASCA. Visit the ASCA site for more details (asca.org). To enter in obedience and rally a dog must have an ASCA tracking number or ASCA registration number. Details on obtaining this can be found on our website www.pennyasc.webs.com under forms, or on the ASCA website (www.asca.org).

Lodging and Directions to Boomtowne Canine Campus

DIRECTIONS:

From the New York State Thruway

1. NYS Thruway to Exit 44 (Canandaigua).
2. Rt. 332 South to Rt. 96 (2nd light).
3. Turn left (east) onto Route 96.
4. Turn right (south) at the first light onto Beaver Creek Road.
5. The Boom Towne Canine Campus will be on your right.

CRATING AT BOOM TOWNE - Crating and grooming space will be available in the daycare room off the main area and also limited crating (with no grooming) in the main arena in designated areas. Indoor crate set up will be allowed Friday after 8:00 pm until 10:00 pm. The building is locked at 10:00 PM. Crates may be left overnight; however, the PEN-NY ASC and the Boom Towne Canine Campus will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Outdoor set up in the agility area will be available after 5:00 pm on Friday.

SITE INFORMATION - All shows will be indoors on rubber matting and plenty of room for crating and grooming. There is no chalking allowed in building and please clean up your area after grooming. Electric outlets are available but are not plentiful. The website to the facility is located here: <http://www.boomtowne.com/>

Dog Park: The dog park is available for our use for the weekend. Dogs that are comfortable being around other dogs off leash are welcome to utilize that area. Please be mindful of your own dog as well as other dogs. In addition, as in all the areas of the facility, cleaning up after your own dog is required when utilizing the dog park

Some Motel courtesies to observe:

- Cover the motel's bedding with a sheet
- If you crate your dog, please bring a towel to put under the crate to keep marks off the rug. Bring a towel to put under your dog's food dish.
- All poop must be picked up, bagged and disposed of properly by the dog's handler. The Event Committee will excuse competitors who fail to pick up after their dogs at the trial site or the motel.
- Don't leave your dog unattended, take them with you.

CAMPING: There is limited (five or six units) self contained camping available at the site. Tent camping is allowed as well. Self-contained sites are available for \$5.00/night. Contact Sue Bartleson at sbartleson@aol.com for reservations. There is also a KOA campground 3-4 miles from the site for those wishing to camp with electric and water hookups.
