## **Trial Regulations:**

- Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished on request.
- Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at end of class.
- All dogs must be kept on leash, except during trial runs. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from trial arenas. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers must pick up after their dogs.
- Australian Shepherds, Australian Shepherd mixes, all other recognized herding breeds and other recognized herding breed mixes are eligible to complete. Recognized herding breeds are listed on the ASCA web site under Stock Dog Trial Regulations.
- All ASCA rules and regulations as stated in the ASCA Stock Dog Trial Regulations booklet will apply. Pre entries open May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 and close May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013. Send entries to Linc Keiser, 291 Long Hill Rd. Middletown, Ct. 06457. Day-of-Trial entries accepted at trial site. Pre-entries encouraged since openings are limited.

## **Courses**

Course B will run Saturday, June 15; Course A will run Sunday, June 16.

## **Stock/Runs**

Sheep and cattle runs will be on three head of stock per run; ducks will be on 5 head per run.

Run order will be determined by random drawing in advance of the trial. Day of trial entries (if any) will be placed at the bottom of the run order in the order received.

## **Stock Injuries**

Injured livestock expenses including veterinary and disposal fees are the responsibility of the handler/owner. Livestock replacement - current market price.

## **Lunch**

Lunch (hamburgers, hotdogs, cold drinks) will be available for purchase at the trial site.

## **Directions to Nutmeg Farm:**

- **From North (north of Hartford)** - Rt 91 South to Hartford. Before downtown Hartford take Rt. 2 East (left exit) to Rt. 17 South (Glastonbury-Portland). Left at Islinglass Hill Road for .7 miles. Turn right on to Thompson Hill Road for 1.4 miles. Turn left on to Old Marlborough Turnpike. Go .4 miles. Turn right on South Road for .6 miles. Farm on right.
- **From North (south of Hartford)** – Take 91 South to 9 South (left exit). At first stoplight in Middletown, take ramp to Main Street. Follow Main Street across Arogoni Bridge into Portland Turn right on to Rt 66 East for 2 miles. Turn left on to Rt 17 North for 2 miles. Turn right on to Sage Hollow Road for .3 miles. Take slight right on to Rose Hill Road for .2 miles. Turn left onto Cox Road for 1.2 miles. Turn left on to South Rd for .3 miles. Farm on left.
- **From West** – Take Rt. 694 East. It becomes Rt. 66 East. Follow to Main Street Middletown. Take left on to Main Street and over the Arogoni Bridge into Portland. Turn right on to Rt 66 East for 2 miles. Turn left on to Rt 17 North for 2 miles. Turn right on to Sage Hollow Road for .3 miles. Take slight right on to Rose Hill Road for .2 miles. Turn left onto Cox Road for 1.2 miles. Turn left on to South Rd for .3 miles. Farm on left.
- **From South** – Take Rt. 9 into Middletown. At second light take left on to ramp that's marked to Portland. Follow signs across Arogoni Bridge into Portland. Then follow directions above.
