The show is in a pole barn on a dirt floor. Bitches in season are not allowed. This is an ASCA sanctioned event, no food or corrections allowed. The show site is available on the days of the trial at 7:00AM.

Ribbons are awarded for qualifying scores and placements.

All dogs must have an individual ASCA registration number or LEP number or an ASCA Tracking number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience and Rally trials.

All dogs must have proof of registration and rabies certificate available.

For information regarding what obedience and rally classes you can enter, and to download entry forms refer to the ASCA rules/forms on the ASCA site <http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms/>

All dogs competing for ASCA obedience titles in the Regular classes are required to start at Novice and work through Utility regardless of titles awarded by other registries

ASCA Obedience judges may not enter or handle in the Novice A class.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation, Obedience or Rally programs, from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.

Effective January 1 2004 All dogs six (6) months or older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or an ASCA tracking number to compete in ASCA Sanctioned obedience trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photocopies or originals of the registration or tracking papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA Obedience trials. ASCA Communicable Disease Policy Obedience 1.34 No Dog shall be eligible to compete at any show, no dog shall be brought into the grounds or premises of any dog show, and any dog which may have been brought into the grounds or premises of a dog show shall immediately be removed, if it; a. shows clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, parvovirus, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease, or b. is known to have been in contact with distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease within thirty days prior to the opening of the show, or c. has been kenneled within thirty days prior to the opening of the show on premises on which there existed distemper, infectious hepatitis, parvovirus, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Directions to Westfield Fairgrounds:

From Interstate 91: Take Exit 15, Holyoke Mall at Ingleside. Turn left at bottom of ramp. Go to second set of lights and turn right onto Homestead Ave. At next light turn left onto Rt. 202. Go approximately 5 miles. Cross Rt. 10 (at light) and go to cemetery on the left. At stop sign turn left. Show site is on the left, about 1 1/2 miles.

From the Massachusetts Turnpike—I-90: Take exit 3. Turn right at the light at the end of the ramp. Go about 100 ft. and make a right onto Arch Road. (Westfield Motor Inn/Westfield Quality Inn is on the corner.) Go about 1.5 miles. With the Southern States Building on your right, make a left onto Cabot Road. Go to the end of Cabot and make a right onto Russellville Rd. Show site is a short distance up on the right.

SOME MOTEL COURTESIES TO OBSERVE:

- Cover the motel's bedding with a sheet, whether or not you think your dog will get on the bed.
- If you crate your dog, please bring a towel to put under the crate to keep marks off the rug. Bring a towel to put under your dog's food dish.
- Make every effort to have your dog free of fleas BEFORE arriving.
- All poop must be picked up, bagged, and disposed of properly by the dog's handler. The Event Committee will excuse competitors who fail to pick up after their dogs at the trial site or the motel.
- Don't leave your dog unattended. If you must leave, take them with you.

Camping on grounds with limited electric and water hook-ups. First arrivals get the first pick with hook-up. No reserved spots except for show committee. Please only parallel park in spaces provided along fence opposite the agility area. Camping reservation form is on the following page.
