Rally

Rally Classes: Novice A, B & C, Advanced A, B & C, Excellent A, B & C, Masters A, B & C,
Each trial will start with the Masters Class

Obedience

Regular Obedience Classes: Utility B,A Open, (ODX/CDX) B,A, Novice - levels B,A,C,

Optional Titling Classes: Beginner Novice levels B,A Graduate Novice

Veterans can jump 4" lower

Each trial will start with Utility.

Novice group stays will be after the individual exercises for all trials

Entries

Rally: Limit 100 entries for the day max 40 per trial

Obedience: Limit 60 entries for the day

Pre-entries: Open on 6/6/2024, close on 7/25/2024 or when the trial is full. Once the trial is full – you can request to be put on a waitlist or have your entry refunded. If the pre-entries fill the trial, there will be no day of show entries taken.

No refunds after the pre-entry closing date

Day of show entries:

Will only be accepted if the trial does not fill during the pre-entry process. Same day move ups are allowed

Trial 1 - Entries taken 7:30 - 8:00. Trial starts at 8:30

Trial 2 - Entries taken 7:30 - 10:30. Trial starts after trial 1 ends.

Trial 3 - Entries taken 7:30 - 1 PM. Trial starts after trial 2 ends. (Saturday only)

A 30-minute lunch may be taken at the discretion of the Judge.

Pre-entry: \$28.00

Pre-entry special: 2 entries – same dog \$50.00, each additional entry \$25.00

Day of show entries: \$30.00, 2 entries – same dog \$55.00 each additional entry \$28.00

This is an ASCA sanctioned show, no food or corrections allowed.

- The trial will be held according to the current ASCA rules and regulations
- The Novice A Class is for handlers that have not placed an Obedience or Rally title on a dog from ASCA or any registry and the dog does not have an Obedience or Rally title from any registry.
- All dogs competing for ASCA titles are required to start at Novice and work through Utility regardless of titles awarded by other Registries.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA

Registration & Tracking

All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.
Effective January 1, 2004: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking (QTracker) number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience or Rally Trials. Directions

From Rt.95 South of Attleboro

Take Exit 2A (Newport Ave.) to the 1st light. Take that left onto Cottage St. Go approximately one mile and turn Right onto Read St. Take 2nd Right onto Pond St. Watch for the Orion Industrial Park on your right (3/10 mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.

From Rt.95 North of Attleboro

From Rt. 95 North of Attleboro: Take Exit 4A Rt. 123. At the 2nd set of lights take a right onto County St. Follow along and after the Stone E Lea golf course take a left onto Read St. (There are signs for the animal shelter). Take the 2nd right onto Pond St. Turn right into the Orion Industrial Park in approximately 3/10 mile. We are the 2nd building on the left.

From Rte. 195 East or West *There may be construction and detours**

Take Massachusetts Exit 1. Follow 114 A (north). In approximately one mile you will reach a fork in the road, bear to the right (Grist Mill Restaurant will be on your left). This is Arcade Street. You will come to the intersection of Route 44. Go Straight across and continue on Arcade to the end. This is the Jct. of Route 152. Take a right onto 152 North – Newman Ave. Follow along for about 5 miles. You will come to the intersection of Central Ave. continue 1/2 mile and take a left onto Pond Street. Watch for Orion Industrial Park on the left (2/10-mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.
