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Rally

Rally Classes: Novice A, B & C, Advanced A, B & C, Excellent A, B & C, Masters A, B & C,
Rally classes order: Masters B/A/C, Excellent B/A/C, Advanced B/A/C, then Novice B/A/C

Obedience

Obedience Classes: Utility B,A Open, (ODX/CDX) B,A, Novice - levels B,A,C
Optional Titling Classes: Graduate Open, Graduate Novice, Beginner Novice B/A.

Obedience Trials will start with Utility. Veterans can jump 4" lower

*** Novice group stays will be after the individual exercises for both trials***
The jumps are non-displaceable wooden jumps

Entries

Rally: Limit 75 entries for the day; max 45 per trial

Obedience: Limit 60 entries for the day; max 35 per trial

Pre-entries: Open on 6/8/2026, close on 7/25/2026 or when the trial is full. Once the trial is full – you can request to be put on a waitlist or have your entry refunded. If the pre-entries fill the trial, there will be no day of show entries taken, or FEO Obedience entries taken (see below).

No refunds after the pre-entry closing date

Day of show entries:

Will only be accepted if the trial does not fill during the pre-entry process. Same day move ups are allowed

Trial 1 - Entries taken 7:30 - 8:00. Trial starts at 8:30

Trial 2 - Entries taken 7:30 - 10:00. Trial starts ½ hr after trial 1 ends.

A 30-minute lunch may be taken at the discretion of the Judge.

Pre-entry: \$28.00

Pre-entry special: 2 entries – same dog \$50.00, each additional entry \$25.00

Day of show entries: \$30.00, 2 entries – same dog \$55.00 each additional entry \$28.00

This is an ASCA sanctioned show, no food or corrections allowed.

Payment can be made by sending in a check or money order with your entries to the pre-entry clerk listed on the Premium or via PayPal at ascnetreasurer1973@gmail.com (please **DO NOT** send as "Friends and Family"). Please include an additional 3% with any PayPal payments along with the owner / exhibitor's name and the show AND venue you are entering. A separate transaction must be made if you are entering multiple venues (ex: 1 transaction for conformation, 1 transaction for agility, etc). Entries are not valid until full payment is made, including the additional 3%.

ASCA Information

- For information regarding what classes you may enter, refer to the rulebooks on the ASCA site: ...
- The trial will be held according to the current ASCA rules and regulations
- The Novice A Class is for handlers that have not placed an Obedience or Rally title on a dog from ASCA or any registry and the dog does not have an Obedience or Rally title from any registry.
- Dogs competing for ASCA titles are required to start at Novice and work through Utility or Masters regardless of titles awarded by other Registries. Optional titling classes do not require start class
- **FEO Obedience runs are now allowed: Entries are accepted after the pre-entry close date if the trial does not fill, see the rule book for complete details, but a flier is attached for an overview of the rules.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA

Registration & Tracking

All Australian Shepherds over the age of 6 months must be registered.
Effective January 1, 2004: All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration or LEP number or and ASCA tracking (QTracker) number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. The handler will be issued a receipt by the Registration table valid for sixty (60) days to allow the Business Office time to issue the tracking number. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience or Rally Trials. FEO runs do not require a QTracker or ASCA registration number

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete. A refund will be made for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial, provided request is made in writing and received no later than the day of the trial.

Directions

From Rt.95 South of Attleboro

Take Exit 2A (Newport Ave.) to the 1st light. Take that left onto Cottage St. Go approximately one mile and turn Right onto Read St. Take 2nd Right onto Pond St. Watch for the Orion Industrial Park on your right (3/10 mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.

From Rt.95 North of Attleboro

From Rt. 95 North of Attleboro: Take Exit 4A Rt. 123. At the 2nd set of lights take a right onto County St. Follow along and after the Stone E Lea golf course take a left onto Read St. (There are signs for the animal shelter). Take the 2nd right onto Pond St. Turn right into the Orion Industrial Park in approximately 3/10 mile. We are the 2nd building on the left.

From Rte. 195 East or West *There may be construction and detours**

Take Massachusetts Exit 1. Follow 114 A (north). In approximately one mile you will reach a fork in the road, bear to the right (Grist Mill Restaurant will be on your left). This is Arcade Street. You will come to the intersection of Route 44. Go Straight across and continue on Arcade to the end. This is the Jct. of Route 152. Take a right onto 152 North – Newman Ave. Follow along for about 5 miles. You will come to the intersection of Central Ave. continue ½ mile and take a left onto Pond Street. Watch for Orion Industrial Park on the left (2/10-mile). Turn into the park, we are the second building on the left.

**Effective June 1, 2026 ASCA is offering
FEO (For Exhibition Only) entries in Obedience**

ALL BREEDS WELCOME

Entries will be allowed for Utility, Open CDX / ODX, and Novice classes ***if the trial entry limit has not been reached***. FEO must be clearly marked on the entry form. ***Dogs entering FEO do not need to be ASCA registered or have a QTracker number***. A dog and handler cannot also be entered in the same regular class as the FEO class entered, e.g. a dog entered in Utility FEO cannot also be entered in Utility A or B. ***Dogs may be entered as FEO in a class for which the dog has not yet earned the prerequisite titles, e.g. a dog with only a CD title but no Open title may enter Utility as FEO***.

- **No food, toys or training**
- **Handlers must follow all ASCA Obedience rules**
- **Fix and go allowed**
- **Handlers may excuse themselves by notifying the judge of their intention**
- **Judges will score each entrant but no final score will be recorded**
- **No ribbons, score announcements or run offs**
- **Runs are not eligible toward any awards, honors or special recognitions**

Handlers will perform the individual exercises at the end of each regular class as follows: Utility B FEO participants will perform the individual exercises after the Utility B class; Utility A FEO will perform the individual exercises after the Utility A class; Open FEO participants will perform the individual exercises after either CDX B, CDX A, ODX B, or ODX A, according to the FEO class entered; Novice FEO participants will perform the individual exercises after the Novice B, A, and C classes. Group exercises may be combined with the regular Novice classes if the total number of dogs per group is less than seven.
