This trial is for purebred Australian Shepherds. This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA. All dogs in Regular Conformation Classes must be at least 6 months of age or older on the day of the show and must have proof of ASCA registration.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; or a dog or handler disqualified from any ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

An individual ASCA registration and Rabies certificate should be available. All fees must be submitted in US Funds. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks will incur a \$25.00 service charge.

FROM POINTS NORTH

Travel Route 83 South through Somers Center, turn right onto Field Road and straight onto Egypt Road. Fairgrounds will be on your right-hand side. Parking lots are located on both sides of the road.

FROM POINTS SOUTH

Travel Route 83 North turning left onto Billings Road and left onto Egypt Road. Fairgrounds will be on your right-hand side. Parking lots are located on both sides of the road.

FROM I-91 AND POINTS WEST

As this is a new venue for us, please bear with us as we work out details. We do know the Four Town Fairground's licensed electrician will be connecting the electrical for **all** RVs. In order to ensure a smooth check-in, we are required to supply (in advance) the number of campers requiring each amount of amp.

In the table below - please indicate the amperage you will require. And your approximate time of arrival (your best guess for now). Every effort will be made to accomodate connecting RVs upon arrival, but those arriving outside of the designated times may need to wait for the electrician to plug in. Please plan accordingly (generators are allowed within non-quiet timeframes.) Once we have an idea of the number of campers, we will coordinate with the fairground's electrician to designate times he will be available.
